Summer Academic Programme

ATC's summer academic programme aims to engage and motivate young learners through active and interesting lessons, encouraging maximum communication between students and helping them grow in confidence while learning English.

The curriculum has been designed against the CEFR and all levels are offered from A1 to C1.

The syllabus operates on a 4 weekly basis and has been designed with the students' experience in mind.

Our timetable is planned so that there are 2 lessons per day, over 5 days, with weekly alternating morning and afternoon classes.

Also Included...

My Learning Journal - A personalised diary for students to make notes from lessons, record new words and phrases, and reflect on what they have learnt each day. This is for use in the classroom and also during the cultural and social activities.

ATC Online - this platform allows students to view their learning outcomes and main task for each lesson. They can also use it to learn about their tours. Access is given to the student and parent for their course and for 12 weeks after their stay with ATC.

Next Generation Workshops - 3 hours per week of theory and practical sessions for students aged 15 years and over, focusing on Job Hunting, CV Preparation and Job Interviews & Techniques. Content includes 21st century skills, critical thinking, creativity and collaboration. Students are encouraged to consider their future employment possibilities and envisage the path that will lead them to their desired vocations.

Or

Conversation Club - 3 hours per week for students aged under 15 years to activate vocabulary from class, develop fluency and practice listening skills. The content encompasses authentic topic areas of life including hobbies, friends and personal interests, as well as wider themes such as inventions through the ages and media and advertising. Students also have an opportunity to practice presentation skills.

STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Maths) - 3 hour workshops providing a fun avenue for younger students to explore English outside of the classroom.

All of our university campus programmes include **ATC On Campus Projects**, designed to encourage creativity while practising spoken interaction. Activities include Photography, Vlogging and Gamezone.
